Zagami Need: Daniel and Sarah Zagami, missionaries working in Clarkston, Georgia with refugees who are resettled there are in need of a newer van. The van they purchased in 2018 is not dependable to drive very far now. It is making noises and Daniel doesn't trust it to go far. They have over 150,000 miles on it. He uses this to deliver items to the refugees: produce, bread, dishes, clothing and small household items. Sarah uses it with their 3 children for everyday travel too. They also have a car, a KIA purchased in 2023 for \$4,500. They would like a 2015-2018 van with around 50,000 miles or less and hope to find it for \$14,000-\$18,000. He is searching for a vehicle now! We will be contacting others churches in our area that have supported them in the past if they would like to help with this project of buying a newer van. If you would like to help with this missionary need, please put a check made out to SCC Missions in the box on the table in the Fellowship Hall by March 15, 2026.
